International Best Book of the Year Award (Tehran, 7 February 2017)

The Middle Path of Moderation in Islam: The Qur'anic Principle of Wasatiyyah was named Best Book of the Year for 2016 at the 24th Iran International Book Festival. The distinguished author, Prof. Mohammad Hashim Kamali, received the prestigious award from President Hassan Rouhani in a special ceremony at Tehran's Vahdat Hall.

In his speech, President Rouhani emphasised that literature should not create conflict among ethnic groups or encourage religious extremism and violence. Rather, works of literature have a duty to promote peace and harmony. The eight award winners at the festival included authors from Malaysia, Iran, Turkey, Germany, Spain, Finland, Romania and England. As a prominent scholar, Prof. Kamali represented Malaysia in the Islamic studies category. A total of 2,500 books were evaluated for the contest.

In his book, published by Oxford University Press in 2015, Prof. Kamali illuminates the concept of moderation (*wasatiyyah*) and elaborates on the manifestations of *wasatiyyah* in the light of the Islamic tradition. In addition, he discusses its application for these pressing contemporary issues: social justice, women's rights, environmental balance, economic fairness and globalisation.
